



## Youth Ministries

### CODE OF CONDUCT:

1. No students may drive to or during youth trips without the **written AND spoken** permission given to Pastor Butch!
2. No student is allowed to go off by themselves; this includes leaving hotel rooms, going to the restroom, etc.!
3. Possession of Tobacco, Alcohol, Illegal Drugs, Firearms, or Pornography will result in immediate dismissal from the event, which will require the student to leave, (if in town) or be picked up from the event by Parents (if out of town).
4. Electronics- No electronics will be permitted on Youth Trips (Cell Phones, IPODs, CD players, DVD players, PSPs, etc.) If these items are seen they will be confiscated by staff and returned to parents at the conclusion of the trip or event.
5. Medicines- Students are required to make staff aware of any prescription medications they may be taking. Over the counter medication will only be given at the request of the parent.
6. We reserve the right to inspect the bags and rooms of all students, and to hold or dispose of any improper contents.
7. Members of the opposite sex are prohibited from visiting or entering each other's rooms, or being alone together at any time!
8. Proper modest attire must be worn at all times. Staff has the right to require students to change if their attire is deemed inappropriate or immodest.
9. All students are required to participate. No student will be permitted to stay at hotel or in vehicles. Participation is mandatory at all events. (Appropriate considerations will be made for sickness)
10. Students may use staff cell phones at the appropriate times, and parents may check in on such phones whenever they would like. (Messages will be checked regularly and return calls will be prompt, but please understand the hurried schedule of retreats can be challenging)!
11. Belvoir Assembly of God and Youth Staff may photograph students during events and retreats and may use such photos from promotional purposes (website, fliers, etc.)
